

4 Line Intercom Speakerphone

with Caller ID, Voice Mail and Auto Attendant

PLUG & PLAY PHONE SYSTEM

The EV4500 has the same features as the ET4000, except that it has 8 memory dials instead of 28. In addition, the EV4500 has the following voice mail and auto attendant features:

Built-in Auto Attendant

Answers incoming calls and directs them to other telephones in the system.

Six Selectable Greetings

You can program the auto attendant and each extension to give up to six different greetings according to the user's input.

This feature is useful for giving specific recorded information to callers, such as hours of operation or directions.

Remote Access and Programming

Allows you to change settings and outgoing messages and settings as well as listen to received messages.

Advanced Voice Mail Options

In addition to giving callers the option of leaving you a message, or hearing a specific recorded message, you can give them the option of ringing another station, or returning to the auto attendant main menu.

Digital Message Recording

30 minute total messages length

Timer-Controlled Greetings

Two messages can be set to play during specific times of the day or night.

Line Specific Greetings

You can assign separate greetings to different lines, which is useful for personal and business lines, or for two separate businesses that share a system.

Voice Mail Lamp

Flashes to indicate at least one new message, lights steady if there are no new messages, but at least one saved message

Message Auto Save

All messages are automatically saved after you review them, until you deliberately erase them.

Message Grouping

When you review your messages, the voice will announce the number of new and saved messages, then will play all new messages, followed by all the saved messages.

Save as New

If you play a message that should be heard by someone else besides you, you may press the "Save as New" button, so that the voice mail lamp will continue to flash, and this message will be played along with any other new messages.



Erase

At any time while listening to a message, you may press this button to erase it. Press this button after all messages have been played to erase all messages.

Screen Calls

If you wish you may listen as callers are leaving you a message. At any time you can pick up the call if you wish.

Skip/Repeat

Use these buttons to jump to the next message, or to go back to the beginning of the current message.

Back/Forward

Press these buttons to jump 5 seconds backward or forward in the currently playing message. This is useful for getting a telephone number you may have missed part of, or to skip through an unimportant part of a message.

Variable Speed Message Playback

You may increase or decrease the speed of the message playback, without altering the voice pitch.

Record Memo/Conversation

With the press of this button, you can record a memo or your current telephone conversation. Your recording will be saved along with the other messages.

Pause/Stop

Use this button to momentarily pause message playback, or to stop message playback at any time.

Telephone Company Voice Mail Compatible

In addition to having a built-in Telephone Company message waiting lamp that is both FSK and stutter dial tone compatible, the voice mail buttons on the telephone (Play, Repeat, Skip, Back, Forward, Pause/Stop, Save, and Erase) also work with Telephone Company voice mail.

When you are using the Telephone Company service, these buttons will send the appropriate DTMF tones when pressed.
